### From the Pastor

This Sunday is Christ the King Sunday which is the triumphant celebration of the end of the church liturgical year. Next Sunday we'll celebrate Advent and the beginning of a new liturgical year. Christ the King Sunday is a relatively new religious observance established in 1925 by decree of Pope Pius XI. Originally it took place on the last Sunday in October, just prior to All Saints' Day. Beginning in 1970 (the year I was born), Christ the King Sunday was celebrated on the last Sunday of the Christian year, a week before the season of Advent begins. On this Sunday, many flavors of Christian churches give thanks and praise for sovereignty of Christ, who is Lord of all creation.

In preparation for worship, I invite you to read, think and pray about Luke 22:33-43. What kind of Savior & king did Jesus turn out to be? How did that encourage and sadden early believers? How did it challenge or confirm their understanding of God's work in the world? How does Jesus challenge or confirm our understanding of what it means to be a king and what God's kingdom may be like?

### **Christmas Eve Poinsettias**


