*From the Pastor*

My thankful heart has overflowed from my eyes more than once this Thanksgiving week! Last Sunday after worship, happy disciples decorated our beautiful facility for the season while others put together thanksgiving boxes for our neighbors in Gallatin county. The laughter and joy was balm to my soul and to others as we prepared to once again make the holy journey of Advent.

The angel tree is up, and there are still angels to be claimed. Advent devotions and calendars arrived and are available. (See article below) We'll kick off intergenerational Sunday School this Sunday. (See article below) There are lots of ways for folks to celebrate the season, to get to know our neighbors and to share the hospitality of Christ. Be sure to pay attention to the newsletter, website and info in the narthex to find out how you can yours can be involved.

This year our advent and Christmas worship and devotion will be shaped by resources from [Illustrated Ministry](#). Now in Flesh Appearing invites God's children of all ages to explore God's taking on a physical body like ours. As we wait with anticipation and prepare for baby Jesus to be born this Advent season, the materials invite us to discover the awesomeness of incarnation and what it means for God to move, act, and live with us. This Sunday kicks off with how we experience hope in our bodies.

In preparation for worship, I encourage you to read John 1:1-5 & 14. John's gospel is a little more abstract or academic than the other gospels, but this is an awe-inspiring invitation to try to wrap our limited human understand around the Trinity. God and Christ and the Spirit are the same and yet different. The Word was always around and became flesh in the Christ child who is God and also God's son.  $1 + 1 + 1 = 1$ . It's enough to give you a headache. Don't get stuck in the hamster wheel of logic that is simply beyond us mere mortals.

I invite you instead to notice the relational nature of God with Godself and the mind-boggling grace offered to creation when "the Word became flesh and lived among us" (John 1:14). How might the early church have heard these words of John? What was comforting? What was challenging? How do we hear these words as individuals and as a faith family in NKY in 2022? What does the Word becoming flesh have to teach us about God and God's love for creation? How does it challenge? Comfort? Inspire us as part of creation and how we embody and live out our faith?
