At noon on Good Friday, March 29th, we will darken the sanctuary at the hour at which Jesus was crucified. You are invited to remember Jesus' sacrifice and prepare the sanctuary for the tenebrae service.

The Good Friday Tenebrae service at 7 pm is a somber service in which candles and the lights in the sanctuary are extinguished with the reading of the Passion story as a reminder that the light of Christ was extinguished for a brief time in his death. What do Presbyterians Believe? Sunday 4/7, 4/14 and 4/28 9am in the Family Room



Most of us tend to think of the second half of life in chronological terms, but this book proposes a different paradigm. Spiritual maturity is found "when we begin to pay attention and seek integrity" through a shift from our "outer task" to the "inner task." What looks like falling



down can be experienced as falling upward—and is not necessarily connected with aging. This new edition focuses on practical guidance that you can use to live a life of love and meaning in a world of suffering and challenge. *Falling Upward* is an invitation to living the gospel and a call to ongoing transformation.


Online Giving
