From the Pastor

First of all, "Thank you!" b everyone who gave so generously of their time and talents to make our Holy Week worship services possible, and to everyone who participated in our amazing Resurrection celebration. It was a communal effort to create a truly holy week! We are all blessed by your generosity. Thanks be to God!

Second of all - Happy Easter! No, I'm not confused. I know Easter Sunday was last Sunday, but..did you know that Easter is a whole liturgical season? Actually, it's Eastertide, but the point is that Easter lasts longer than just one day. Eastertide is the 49 days from Easter to the day before Pentecost and is a period that invites us to continue to celebrate Jesus' resurrection and to consider how our lives are transformed by it.

In his resurrection, Jesus the Christ broke the chains of sin and death for all of creation and transformed us into Easter people. We are Easter people not just for one day a year but all the other 364/5 days as well. Eastertide is when "the rubber meets the road" so to speak. We are challenged to put feet to our faith and to live as though Jesus' resurrection makes a difference - because it makes ALL the difference.

Throughout Eastertide we will journey through the Revised Common Lectionary texts each week and explore how the scripture invites us to experience the Risen Christ while living out our calling as a Matthew 25 congregation. Each week of Eastertide, you will be invited to be on the lookout to experience the Risen Christ in the world around you and to share that experience in a picture, story, poem, etc. A screen in the chancel serves as a display area for these sightings. You may include your name or not on your reflection; however, please put your name on the back of your offering if you wish for it to be returned to you after Pentecost. You may also email me things you'd like to share by clicking here.

To prepare for this Sunday's worship, I encourage you to read Acts 8:32-35. The people with whom Peter and John were sharing the good news of the Risen Christ were moved by the Spirit and were "of one heart and soul" and and put Easter into action. Think and pray about these texts. With whom do you identify in the story - Peter & John? the religious officials? the people who

came to believe? On this side of the resurrection with whom do you believe? How might the Spirit be leading us to be Easter people in action as individual disciples and as a community of faith?

The challenge for this week is to look for Easter people in action. It could be at UPC. It could be in the community. It could be something on the news or in a book or a song. Take a picture. 
