From the Pastor

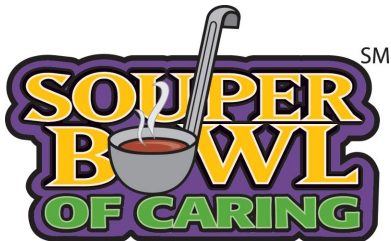
The newsletter is late because I've been at a conference.

Our UPSeniors have invited others to join them for this special presentation by Dr. Ron Savignano, a local chiropractor, on the health benefits of CBD products. CBD stands for cannabidiol, which is derived directly from the hemp plant, which is a cousin of the marijuana plant. While CBD is a component of marijuana (one of hundreds), by itself it does not cause a "high."

CBD is currently being used to treat conditions from muscle soreness to fatigue and depression. Dr. Savignano will discuss how CBD works and current studies and anecdotal evidence of its effectiveness. The presentation will last approximately 45 minutes with time at the end for Q&A.
